If you pay by the week the fee is \$18.00 per week.

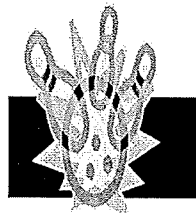

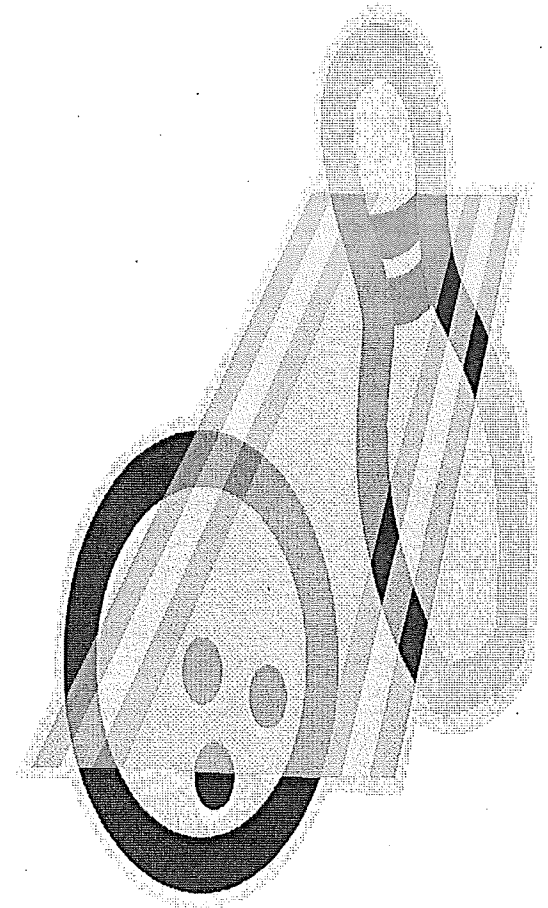

## ***BOWLERS INFORMATION***

Start time, bowling will start promptly at 6:00 pm.

**Equipment: Bowlers must have their own bowling balls**

**Missed sessions:** If a bowler is going to miss a bowling session they need to call the coach. The coach must be notified in advance if you are going to be absent for the session.

**Transportation:** Bowlers will provide their own transportation to and from the bowling alley. Bowlers may arrive at the bowling alley 15 minutes prior to start time and be picked up at approximately 2 1/2 hours from start time.

**Appropriate Attire;** please dress appropriately, shorts, jeans, tee shirts, and tank tops are okay. If you come to the session in inappropriate attire, you will be sent home to change.

## ***COACHING***

### **Coaching Staff**

Coach Dale Lehman began his coaching career at Zion Benton High School in 2002. He coached at Zion for five years, winning three Conference Championships, and he coached three State Qualifiers. He was hired by Robert Morris University, and founded the bowling program in 2005. Coach Lehman and his staff coached 24 NCBCA All Americans, 3 NCBCA Rookies of the Year, and 2 NCBCA Players of the Year. They coached 30 NAIA All Americans, 2 NAIA Rookies of the Year and 2 NAIA Players of the Year. Coach Lehman was a finalist for Coach of the Year 8 years in a row, and was named NAIA Coach of the Year in 2013. He has also been listed as one of the top One Hundred Coaches in Bowlers Journal. The RMU bowling teams won 7 National Team Championships and 3 National Singles Championships. They were NAIA National Champions in 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016, and the USBC Intercollegiate Champions in 2013 and 2014. Coach Lehman is a USBC Silver Level Coach and former RMU Head Coach.
